Search Strategy Suggestions For Electronic Resources:

To reduce the number of false hits about African-Americans, try: **africa* not america***
 Some search engines will use AND NOT; some capitalize NOT. In Google try: **africa -america**
 Google does not allow the truncation feature (*) but has a "related terms" feature (~africa).
