Need a book we don't have? Try SUMMIT (orbis.uoregon.edu) to identify items; request Interlibrary Loan.

2. E-Books: (Research Gateway >> Find eBooks)

NetLibrary: To use the thousands of current, academic e-books in our *NetLibrary* collection from off-campus, first sign up on a CCC computer. (Open NetLibrary and click the "Create a Free Account" link.)

Freebies: Classic, out-of-copyright literary, scientific, and historical works are readily available on the Web, as are many current titles from the National Academies Press and various university presses. From our web page, choose **Research Gateway >> Find eBooks**.



Periodicals: Research, News, Hot Topics & Features

Journals: formal, peer-reviewed articles in which researchers report their new work

Magazines: news and features for non-specialists or the general public

Trade Journals: news and features for professionals

Article Indexes (Access: Research Gateway >> Find Articles)

EBSCO Indexes: ask for passwords to use these from home

Academic Search Premier - all-purpose index for undergraduate research, extensive full-text

* ***Professional Development Collection*** (from EBSCO) – focuses on Education, extensive full-text

ERIC (from EBSCO) comprehensive education index, very limited full-text

PrimarySearch, MiddleSearch, MAS-Ultra (from EBSCO) – aimed at K-12 **students**.

Try the **SUBJECT** tab to browse subject headings for more precise results.

Use **Revise Search** to find only... easily available items (**full text/ held at CCC**); items >1p. long

Other article indexes exist! If you are not getting enough information on your topic, ask us!

Articles not available at CCC or from these indexes may be obtained through Interlibrary Loan.
