Note: addict* retrieves <i>addict, addiction, addictive, addicts...</i> Check the subject headings assigned to items for additional useful search terms!

2. E-Books:

NetLibrary: CCC Library subscribes to thousands of current, academic e-books from *netLibrary*; access items through *CougarCat* or (once you have signed up on a CCC computer) directly from www.netlibrary.com.

Freebies: Both classic scientific works and hundreds of current titles from the **National Academies Press** are available online for free. From our web page, choose **Research Gateway >> Find eBooks**.



Periodicals: Research, News, Hot Topics & Features

Journals: formal, peer-reviewed articles in which researchers report their new work

Magazines: news and features for non-specialists or the general public

Trade Journals: news and features for professionals

Article Indexes:

Academic Search Premier (EBSCO)

Covers 6000 journals, magazines, and newspapers in all areas of study; with many full-text articles.

Medline (EBSCO) – citations (little full-text) to articles from professional medical journals

CINAHL (EBSCO) -- citations (little full-text) to articles from professional nursing / allied health journals
