SEARCH STATEMENT TIPS & EXAMPLES:

|----------------------------------|--|
| meth labs | finds items with the word <i>meth</i> and the word <i>labs</i> |
| “assisted suicide” | finds items with the exact phrase <i>assisted suicide</i> |
| cougar OR “mountain lion” | finds items with either the word <i>cougar</i> or the phrase <i>mountain lion</i> |
| gypsy NOT moths | finds items with <i>gypsy</i> ; then discards any that also have <i>moths</i> |
| pollut* | finds items with <i>pollute, polluted, polluter(s), pollution...</i> (truncation) |
| wom?n | finds items with <i>woman</i> or <i>women</i> - ? substitutes for any one character |
| tsunami NEAR4 oregon | finds items with <i>tsunami</i> within 4 words of <i>Oregon</i> |

ADVANCED SEARCH SCREEN

Advanced Search allows you to tell NewsBank **where** in the newspapers to search.

SEARCHING: New York Times, The (NY)

for: domestic NEAR3 (wiretap* OR spy*) in Lead/First Paragraph

AND editorials in Section

return: Most recent matches first

timeframe: the past 3 months

custom date:

Choices include:
All Text; Headline; Lead Paragraph; Author;
Section; Edition; Source (newspaper)

Use **Section** to specify common
newspaper sections such as:
Business; Dining; Editorial; Fashion; Food;
Living; Local; Obituaries; Sports
