Article Indexes:

The following indexes may be accessed from the Library's website. CCC students may obtain passwords at the Reference Desk for off-campus access to subscription indexes

CINAHL (Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature). (EBSCO; CCC subscription)

Indexes 1600 publications, including 500 nursing journals. Links to full text in other indexes.

Health Source: Nursing / Academic Edition (EBSCO; CCC subscription)

500 publications in nursing, medicine and allied health; many full-text articles

PubMed (MEDLINE) (www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/PubMed)

Free government index of medical and nursing journals (no full text).

MedlinePlus (medlineplus.gov/) is a compilation of general / consumer health information.

Academic Search Premier (EBSCO; CCC subscription)

Covers 3000 journals & magazines in all subjects; many **full-text** articles.

Newsfile (NewsBank; CCC subscription) Full text articles from over 500 U.S. Newspapers.

Oregonian (NewsBank; CCC subscription) Full text *Oregonian* articles, 1988-present.

Obtaining Articles

Owned at CCC: Alphabetical by journal title in the **Periodicals** section.
 Not owned at CCC: Request an article by **Interlibrary Loan** (form at Circulation Desk)
 Check **Summit catalog** for other area libraries that own the title

Background Information & Quick Facts: Reference Materials


