Article Indexes:

Academic Search Premier (From Library website: Research Gateway >> Find Articles >> EBSCO)

Covers 6000 journals, magazines and newspapers in all areas of study; with many full-text articles.

MEDLINE – From the National Library of Medicine; searches over 4800 current biomedical journals

Psychology & Behavioral Sciences Collection – Close to 600 publications (many full-text) on wide variety of psychological and related topics; most indexed in *PsycINFO*.
