2. E-Books:

netLibrary: CCC Library subscribes to thousands of current, academic e-books from *netLibrary*; access via *CougarCat* or (once you have signed up on a CCC computer) directly from www.netlibrary.com.

3. Children's Books

Academic Search Premier (EBSCO)

Covers 6000 journals, magazines and newspapers in all areas of study; with many full-text articles.

Health Source: Consumer Edition (EBSCO)

500 health-related publications; many full-text articles

MasterFile Premier (EBSCO)

Covers more popular magazines and fewer scholarly journals than Academic Search Premier.

Newsbank Newsfile - Full text articles from over 500 U.S. Newspapers.

Oregonian - Full text articles from the Oregonian newspaper, with extensive backfile.

Obtaining Articles

Owned at CCC: Alphabetical by journal title in the **Periodicals** section.

Not owned at CCC: Request an article by **Interlibrary Loan** (form at Circulation Desk)
